The Oaks trip to St Nicholas Priory

The Oaks have a wonderful opportunity to visit St Nicholas Priory and Exeter Cathedral on Tuesday 25th February as part of our history topic covering The Tudors.

The trip will take place within the school day, so children can be dropped off and picked up at the usual times. They will need to wear school uniform for the trip and must also have a waterproof coat with a hood.
