We have had another wonderful week in Hollies class

This week saw our inaugural times table club and the children had a fabulously competitive time playing games, beating the clock and experiencing the official DfE pupil practice MTC site. It was great to see so many children, same time, same place next week.

We used primary and secondary sources to infer the purpose of tombs, pyramids and temples for ancient Egyptians. I was particularly impressed with how the children made sure they were using the sources 'as historians'. During lessons, we put a lot of focus on the children backing up their reasoning with evidence to ensure they are not just making assumptions based on acquired knowledge.
