Census Day – Thursday 3rd October 2024

This is an important day for the school as funding is allocated by the Department for Education. As this funding is based on how many children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 take up their entitlement to a Universal Free School Meal, we are hoping that all children in those year groups will have a school lunch on this day.

As you are aware, the Trust recently held a competition named “The Great British Harvest”, giving all children across the Trust the opportunity to design a menu that would be served to all children in our schools on Census Day!

The winning menu was chosen submitted by St Marks C of E Academy and chosen by our Trust Executive Team. Children can choose from the main or vegetarian options of:

- Toad-in-the-Hole with Broccoli and Mashed Potato (Choose Census Day MAIN option)
- Pumpkin & Chickpea Curry with Rice & Broccoli (Choose the Census Day VEG option)

Dessert will be:

- Blackberry & Fruit Crumble with Custard

There will also be the usual option for sandwiches and wraps. This is completely free of charge to pupils in EYFS and KS1 as these year groups are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. *All FSM & UNiFSM children will be automatically included for lunch on this day unless parents opt out.*

As a thank you for everyone’s support with the competition, **lunch will be FREE for ALL children on Thursday including those in KS2!** Please book your child’s lunch online via the MCAS App by 10.00am on Wednesday 2nd October. If you need a password reset, contact the school office.

The school in the Trust with the highest attendance on Thursday 3rd October will receive a boost of up to £1500.00! We all have our fingers crossed that our attendance will be the highest in the Trust and know that our families will support us with this!

Pupil Premium Funding

Did you know that even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and receives the Universal Free School Meals, the school could be entitled to extra top up funding from the Government. This is called Pupil Premium funding:

Gov.uk says:

“Pupil premium is funding to improve education outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in schools in England. Evidence shows that disadvantaged children generally face additional challenges in reaching their potential at school and often do not perform as well as other pupils. Your child's school may be entitled to **pupil premium** funding if you receive one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit
- National Asylum Seekers Support
- Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance (income related)
- Universal Credit (income dependant)

How does my school get the pupil premium for my child?

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2



All children at this age are eligible for Universal Free School Meals so you will need to apply separately for the pupil premium for your child's school.

“Please be aware that a child must reside with the applicant to receive the pupil premium.”
