

Dear Parent or Carer

Torbay Council's Cycling Instructors will be at the school from Wednesday 23 to Friday 25 April to deliver Bikeability Level 2 to Year 5 pupils. The training is also open to Year 6 pupils who missed it last year, or feel that they need to refresh their skills

This is a 4-day course with 2-hour sessions each day. The training will take place on quiet roads and show them how to make safe journeys on their bikes.

Children must be able to ride a cycle without stabilisers to take part.

If your child doesn't have a bike, Torbay Furniture Project CIC, a non-profit making organisation, sell refurbished bikes at great prices. They are at 56 Winner Street, Paignton TQ3 3BQ. You can contact them via their [Facebook Page](#)

If your child's bike is broken in any way, Cycle Torbay CIC can help with this, free of charge, either at the Cycle Hub in Paignton, or at their pop-up sessions around the Bay. For a complete list of sessions check out their website.
